POSITON SUMMARY

The MSW provides psychosocial assessments, diagnoses and intervention. They plan and consult with patients, families and the health care team with regards to discharges. MSW's prepare the patient and family to manage patient hospitalization, illness, diagnosis, treatment, and/or life situation, including emotional, mental, and substance abuse disorders.

The goal of the MSW's practice is to restore, maintain and enhance emotional and social functioning by mobilizing strengths, supporting coping capacities, helping people modify ineffective patterns of relating and behaving, linking people to necessary resources, alleviating environmental stressors and providing psychosocial education related to wellness and subjective well-being.

The MSW ensures that patients are provided care in accordance with policies, procedures, standards and regulations. Social worker acts as a support and guide to enable patients to help themselves while maintaining a professional relationship with patients and families.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide social work intervention plans and psychosocial assessment, if required
- Provide psychosocial support to patient and families affected by chronic, acute, or terminal illnesses.
- Advise family caregivers, counsel patients, and help plan for patients' needs after discharge.
- Develop client centered goals and intervention plans

- Consult with doctors, therapists and medical professional
- Direct patients to other areas of assistance as required, and help patients and their families find services in the community
- Collaborate with other health care professionals in regards to the patient, when required to ensure seamless care
- Provide social work counselling to clients including both one-on-one counselling and group counselling as required
- Mobilize patients support systems, as needed, to improve patients psychosocial functioning
- Engage in case conferencing with families and/or community agencies, when needed, in order to assist a patient to improve psychosocial functioning
- Maintain treatment records for each patient and prepare verbal and written reports and correspondence related to the work
- Develop and implement programs as assigned
- Work with members of a multi-disciplinary team in diagnosing problems, formulating treatment plans, and evaluating progress
- Provide social work intervention in accordance with medical treatment plans and modify plans to meet the client's goals
- Assist patients in their continuing adjustment to the community and evaluate their need for further care and potential need of placements
- Maintain sustainable working relationships with community agencies, schools, law enforcement and courts
- Attend monthly scheduled staff meetings
- Participate in continuing education activities and assist in the in-service training of other employees
- Perform other associated duties as required.

- Completion of Masters degree in Social Work (MSW)
- Valid Social Work license or registration as required by the province, with no limitations on license that could interfere with position duties
- Membership in the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers (OCSWSSW)
- 2 years recent post-master experience in a clinical setting preferred
- Require professional liability insurance
